Chinese New Year Celebrations on Friday, 9 February 2024

Our Chinese New Year celebrations will be held on Friday, 9 February 2024. This is an opportunity for students and staff of different races to come together and celebrate the Chinese tradition and culture. The school will be planning activities including a concert and the blessing of oranges.

Your child can bring along 2 mandarin oranges to school on Friday, 9 February 2024 if she wants to participate in the blessing of oranges. Your child is to come in her school uniform with school shoes.

All students are to report to school by 7.25am and will be dismissed **by** 10.30am. To minimise overcrowding, we will implement staggered dismissal:

There will be no afternoon activities that day, i.e. CCA, support lessons and enrichment programmes. The bookshop and canteen will also be closed that day.

There will be no classes for all students on Monday, 12 February 2024 and Tuesday, 13 February 2024. Classes will resume on Wednesday, 14 February 2024.



General Information

Total Defence Day

This year, we are commemorating 40 years of Total Defence with the theme “Together, We Keep Singapore Strong”.

Known as TD40, its focus will be on Singaporean’s readiness and resilience in the face of crises and disruptions. Total Defence underpins our ability to deal with the ever-evolving threats and challenges to Singapore. After all, Singapore depends on every Singaporean playing their part to ensure that Singapore is prepared for crises and disruption.

As part of our commemoration of TD40 this year, the school will be having a special assembly programme on Wednesday, 14 February 2024 as well as a food disruption simulation and lights-off exercise on Friday, 16 February 2024. School hours are as per normal on both days.

On Friday, 16 February 2024, the canteen will not serve any form of meat (e.g., chicken, fish, pork, beef, mutton and seafood) on that day to encourage students to be flexible in food choices and be open to protein alternatives in the event of such disruptions. In addition, our students will also experience an hour of lights-off (similar to Earth Hour) in the school. After the exercise, our students will get to reflect and share on their experience.

Do ask your child about the event and get her to share her learning with you and your family. You can share with her your own thoughts on Total Defence and other National Education events that you attended when in school, and how each of us can make a difference to Singapore.

Absences from Weighted Assessments

As with any school day, a student should not be in school if she is unwell. Please make the necessary arrangements to bring your child/ward to see a doctor and submit the medical certificate to the Form Teacher upon her return to school. This applies on days when weighted assessments take place too.

The purpose of assessment including Weighted Assessments is to check for students' understanding and to provide timely feedback to improve learning. As such, while make-up sessions will not be scheduled for students who are absent from any component(s)/ paper(s), **students who missed their written assessment will be given a set of the affected assessment papers as an optional assignment.** They are encouraged to complete the paper at home independently and at one sitting. The subject teacher will mark the assignment and provide feedback on the student's progress. The marks will not be included in the computation of the Overall Performance for the year.
