Dear Parents / Guardian,

P6 English and Mother Tongue Language Preliminary Oral Examination 2017

1. Your daughter/ward is required to sit for the Preliminary English and Mother Tongue Language Oral Examination on **29 July 2017 (Saturday)** from 8.00am to 1.00pm. The reporting time to school is **7.15am**. The examination is divided into 2 sessions:
 - Session 1 – 8.00am to 10.10am
 - Session 2 – 11.00am to 1.00pm

2. **Students are required to attend both sessions.** There will be a break from 10.10am to 10.35am and food will be sold at the canteen. All students are to be dressed in their school uniform.

3. The exam schedule for both sessions is as follows:

Session	English Language (EL)	Mother Tongue Languages (MT)
Session 1: 8.00am – 10.10am	6F, 6G & 6J	6H, 6L, 6P & 6T
Session 2: 11.00am – 1.00pm	6T, 6P, 6L & 6H	6J, 6G & 6F

4. There will be a briefing for all students closer to the date of the examination to inform them of their examining teams and order in which they will sit for their oral examination. This information will also be displayed on every class' bulletin board.
5. The schedule for some candidates sitting for Malay and Tamil Languages may change. In these cases, the Malay and Tamil Language teachers for affected students will inform them of their exam schedule.
6. Please also take note of the following:
 - Students will be dismissed immediately after they have been tested in the **second session**. The estimated time for each candidate is 10 minutes for EL and 15 minutes for MTL. Please ensure that transport arrangements are made for your daughters. Do note as well that for security reasons, students will only be dismissed from Side Gate 2 and that parents will not allowed to drive into the school compound to pick the girls up.
 - Students who are exempted from MT Oral, who take NTIL or who are offering an alternative language as MT, will either be dismissed after the first session or only report for the second session. These candidates will receive a separate letter reminding them of their dismissal or reporting time. Please take note of this if it applies to your daughter and ensure transport arrangements are made for her to go home or report punctually for her session.
 - Students who are unwell on the day of the exam are advised to seek medical attention and to hand in their Medical Certificates to their respective Form Teachers upon their return to school so that a make-up session can be arranged.
