Travel Declaration (Online via Learning Management System)

If your child is travelling overseas during the school holidays (26 May - 24 Jun), please provide us with her travel details online via her Learning Management System (LMS) account by Friday, 25 May 2018 if you have not already done so. A "nil" reply is necessary. If you do not have computers or internet access at home, please let your child's Form Teacher know. She/He will then give you a hard copy of the form. P6 National Education (NE) Quiz

All P6 pupils (including Permanent Residents and International Students) will need to sit for a NE Quiz from 9 July 2018 to 20 July 2018. The quiz will be conducted during their Social Studies (SS) periods. This quiz tests the pupils' knowledge and understanding of NE. As in previous years, pupils are required to pass the quiz in order to be promoted to Secondary 1.

In addition to teachers reviewing the topics with pupils during SS lessons in Term 3, teachers have also prepared an online revision module to assist their pupils further. Pupils will be able to access this module from Monday, 28 May 2018.

School Bus Service during the June holidays

For pupils who regularly commute to and from school on the school buses, Min Yang Transport will continue to provide bus service to school and home during the holidays. However, due to its other commitments, Min Yang Transport is only able to do so at about its usual times, i.e. girls will be picked up at about the usual time and take the bus home at 1pm. There may be some adjustments to the pick-up times (from home). Temperature-Taking Exercise on 28 June 2018

As part of our preparation for the temperature-taking exercise, please remind your child to bring along her Oral Digital Thermometer (ODT) when school reopens on Monday, 25 June 2018. If you require a new ODT, you can purchase an ODT from any pharmacy.

CHIJ OLN Emergency Exercise (6 July 2018)

We will be conducting an emergency exercise on Friday, 6 July 2018 from 9.00am to 11.00am. This will include an evacuation exercise to an external holding area i.e. Holy Innocent's High School.

This emergency exercise aims to train the staff and pupils to be prepared for any emergency in the school premises and to be familiar with the safety and evacuation procedures. It is a collaborative effort between the school, the Ministry of Education's Security and Emergency Planning Office (SEMPO) and the Singapore Police Force (SPF). Therefore, please do not be alarmed when you see ambulances and police cars entering the school premises and Holy Innocent's High School.

School will start as per normal at 7.45am and dismissal will be at 11.30am. Please make the necessary transport arrangement to fetch your child at 11.30am. There will be no after-school activities on 6 July 2018. In the event of inclement weather e.g. thunderstorms, the evacuation exercise will be cancelled and dismissal will still take place at 11.30am.
