2. Please note that the weighting for English Language, Mother Tongue Languages, Mathematics and Science for End-of-Year Examination is **70%** of the overall assessment for the year.
3. The End-of-Year Oral Exam for English and Mother Tongue Languages will be held over two days (see para 1) after curriculum hours. Please note that there will be no support lessons /CCA on these two days. Your daughter will be informed of the subject in which she will be examined and the sequence of examination on each of the respective dates by her subject teacher. **Your daughter will be dismissed once she has sat for her oral exam each day.**
4. Students who are picked up by parents/caregivers will be allowed to contact their parents/caregivers once they have sat for their oral exam. There will be teachers to accompany students as they wait for their parents and caregivers.
5. Students who are absent on the first day will be tested on the second day. **The final day for the oral make-up exam is 21 October 2022.** There will be no further make-up sessions beyond this day/date.
6. There is a bus service to provide students with transport home at 3.00 pm and 5.00 pm. As the bus company will charge parents for this additional bus service and needs to plan the routes in advance, please contact KW Transport at 84984950 **at least 3 working days in advance** to register your child for the bus service. The bus vendor will not be able to accept late registration of bus services as this will affect the drop-off time of the other students on the bus. Alternatively, you may make your own transport arrangements for your child.
7. For your daughter's well-being, they will not be allowed to take any component(s)/paper(s) if they are unwell on the day of assessment. Please make the necessary arrangements to bring your child to see a doctor and to obtain a medical certificate, if she is unwell.
8. There will be no make-up tests for students who are absent for any written component(s)/ paper(s). Any absence must be supported with a Medical Certificate from a doctor. Letters from parents will not be accepted, unless there is a valid reason and this is subject to the Principal's approval. Medical certificates from Traditional Chinese Medicine practitioners will not be accepted.
9. Students who report to school after the commencement of a paper may not be allowed to sit for it, unless there is a valid reason and this is subject to the Principal's approval.
10. Our students are strongly encouraged to draw up a timetable to help them better prepare for the assessments. Do ensure your daughter takes into consideration her physical and emotional well-being as she draws up her timetable. We also encourage all students to complete their HBL assignments (17 – 20 October). The task sheets will be made available by 16 October 2022, 6p.m.
