Dear Parents / Guardian,

School-Wide Learning Journey: Boat Quay and Little India (Primary Six)

1. We are glad to inform you that we will be able to conduct our second School-Wide Learning Journey (SWLJ) this semester with the easing of Safe Management Measures (SMMs).
2. The intent of the School-Wide Learning Journey (SWLJs) is to extend and enrich our students' learning experiences by integrating field-based learning into the teaching and learning programme. It also provides all students with opportunities to explore their Singaporean identity and heritage beyond their classrooms.
3. This semester, Primary Six students will be going on trails to Boat Quay and Little India. Through the trails, they will learn about what life was like in the past and understand the role of the early settlers in Singapore. They will understand how these contributions lead to the progress and development of our country. Students will explore the various significant sites in Boat Quay and Little India.
4. The learning journey will take place during school hours on Thursday, 6 October 2022. Students will report to school as usual by 7.30 a.m. Dismissal time remains unchanged.
5. As the students will be spending the day out of school, we seek your help to pack a snack for your child to be consumed at about 10.00 a.m. They will also be provided a snack pack each. All students would need to bring along their water bottles. Please ensure that your child has a substantial breakfast as canteen stalls will not be operating that day.
6. While contingency plans have been made in case of inclement weather, please also pack an umbrella or raincoat for your child as a precaution. She will also need to have her stationery, e.g. a pen, with her as some activities will require writing.
7. You will receive a School Bill in October with information as to the payment mode.

For Singapore citizens: **\$20.00** will be deducted from your child's/ward's Edusave account.

For Singapore Permanent Residents and International Students: If you are not using GIRO payment for the School Bill, you can use the generated School Bill to make payment of **\$20.00** via the SingPost Self-Automated Machine (SAM). Alternatively, you can pay cash or issue a cheque payable to "Ministry of Education" by the date due reflected in the School Bill.

8. There will be no refund for the programme if you wish to withdraw your child/ward from this SWLJ after 30 September 2022, or if your child is absent for the programme without any valid reason.
9. Please submit your consent for this programme via Parents Gateway by **30 September 2022 (Friday)**. If you have any queries, please contact the Form Teacher via email.
