- 4. There will be no make-up tests for students who are absent from written component(s)/ paper(s). Any absence must be supported with a Medical Certificate from a doctor. Letters from parents will not be accepted, unless there is a valid reason and this is subject to the Principal's approval. Medical certificates from Traditional Chinese Medicine practitioners will not be recognised.
- 5. Students who are absent on the day of their oral exam will be scheduled to sit for it on the day they return. The final day for the oral exam make-up is 17 October 2024. There will be no further make-up session beyond this day / date.
