3. For your daughter's well-being, she will not be allowed to take any component(s)/paper(s) if she is unwell on the day of assessment. Please make the necessary arrangements to bring your daughter to see a doctor and to obtain a medical certificate if she is unwell.
4. There will be no make-up tests for students who are absent from written component(s)/ paper(s). Any absence must be supported with a Medical Certificate from a doctor. Letters from parents will not be accepted, unless there is a valid reason and this is subject to the Principal's approval. Medical certificates from Traditional Chinese Medicine practitioners will not be recognised.
5. Students who are absent on the day of their oral exam will be scheduled to sit for it on the day they return. **The final day for the oral exam make-up is 17 October 2024.** There will be no further make-up session beyond this day / date.

6. Students who report to school after the commencement of a paper may not be allowed to sit for it unless there is a valid reason and this is subject to the Principal's approval.
7. Our students are strongly encouraged to draw up a timetable to help them better prepare for the assessments. Do ensure your daughter takes into consideration her physical and emotional well-being as she draws up her timetable.
8. We also encourage all students to complete their HBL assignments (14 – 16 October). The task sheets will be made available by **11 October 2024, 6 p.m.**
