Project G.O.O.D. - Gift of One Dollar and Sale of Hot Cross Buns

During the Lent season, our students were challenged to set aside a portion of their pocket money each day to gift a total of a dollar to the less fortunate. We are proud to have raised \$2724.55 for the CHIJ Sanctuary for Children (CHIJS) through our Project G.O.O.D collections

on Wednesday, 1 April 2026.

Through the sale of the Hot Cross buns on Thursday, 2 April 2026, we also raised an additional \$182.50 for the CHIJS, bringing the total amount to \$2907.05. We are very proud of our girls for their generosity of heart!

Praying the Rosary (4 - 29 May 2026)

General Information

Absences from Weighted Assessments

As with any school day, students should not attend school if they are unwell. Please arrange for your child/ward to see a doctor and submit the medical certificate to the Form Teacher upon return to school. This applies on Weighted Assessment days as well.

The purpose of assessments, including Weighted Assessments, is to check students' understanding and provide timely feedback to improve learning. While make-up sessions will not be scheduled for students absent from any component or paper, **students who miss written assessments will receive the affected papers as an optional assignment.** They are encouraged to complete the paper at home independently in one sitting. The subject teacher will mark the assignment and provide feedback on progress. These marks will not be included in the Overall Performance computation for the year.

We seek your cooperation in teaching our students to be responsible and take ownership of their learning.

2026 Direct School Admission for Secondary Schools (DSA-Sec)

DSA-Sec aims to promote holistic education and is based on a diverse range of talents and achievements. P6 students can seek admission to a secondary school via this alternative route. Each secondary school offers distinctive programmes and sets its own selection process and criteria to admit students with talents that can be further developed by these programmes.

Travel Declaration for June School Holidays

If there is a need to amend the travel plan, you can do so via the same module in PG. If your child/ward is not travelling during the holidays or the long weekends, no action is required.

P1 to P6 Parent-Teacher-Student Conferencing (PTSC) (25 & 26 May)

This semester, the P1 to P6 PTSC will be held face-to-face in school. During the session, the Form Teachers will share their observations regarding your child's/ward's overall progress in school. You will also have the opportunity to hear your child/ward share about her own growth and the challenges she has faced.

You would have received the notification via Parents Gateway (PG) on Friday, 17 April 2026 with details on how you could book a session via PG by Monday, 4 May 2026. Please note that there will be no lessons for the students on 25 and 26 May 2026. When your child/ward comes to school with you for the PTSC session, she is required to be in her school uniform and school shoes. If you are driving to school, you would need to park at the HDB carpark next to the school.

We strongly encourage you to book a session with the teachers. Our students are very excited preparing for the session and will be most happy if they get the chance to share their thoughts with you in front of their Form Teachers.
