National Day Celebrations

The school will celebrate National Day on Friday, 7 August 2026. The theme is **“Majulah Singapura, Go Beyond!”**

“Majulah Singapura” captures our Singapore Spirit and our enduring aspirations to keep moving forward and to progress. “Go Beyond!” is our call to action to do better for Singapore and

Singaporeans, and to show care and concern for one another and our wider community.

All students are to report to school by 7.25am and will be dismissed at 10.30am. To minimise overcrowding, we will implement staggered dismissal:

As the bookshop and canteen will be closed, we will implement snack time for all levels instead. There will be no afternoon activities that day, i.e. support lessons, P6 supplementary lessons and CCA. Please make the necessary transport arrangements for your child/ward to return home if she is not taking the school bus.

Students are encouraged to wear a red T-shirt with their pinafore and school shoes. They should bring along a small bag with a water bottle, a story book, stationery and some healthy dry snacks.

PSLE Examination Dates

1. PSLE Oral (12 and 13 August 2026)

2. PSLE Listening Comprehension (15 September 2026)

The PSLE Oral and Listening Comprehension examinations for Primary 6 students will take place on the dates stated above. **There will be no school for P1 - P5 students on the above dates.**

To ensure a safe and conducive environment for the examination, the school will not admit visitors on these days. This includes parents, caregivers and P1 to P5 students for non-emergency cases, e.g. collection of homework or retrieval of lost items. Please remind your child/ward to bring home whatever she needs. A few canteen stalls will be open on the day of the PSLE Listening Comprehension (i.e. 15 September 2026) to cater to the Primary 6 students. However, the bookshop and dental clinic will be closed on these 3 days.

3. PSLE Written Papers (24 - 30 September 2026)

The PSLE Written examinations for Primary 6 students will take place from 24 to 30 September 2026. P6 students are dismissed at the end of each paper. Here are the reporting arrangements for P1 to P5 students:

P4	Students do not report to school from Thursday to Monday, 24 to 28 September 2026. Instead they will have Home-Based Learning from Thursday to Monday, 24 to 28 September 2026. Students report to school as per normal from 29 September 2026 onwards.
P5	Students will have Home-Based Learning from Thursday to Monday, 24 to 28 September 2026. Students report to school as per normal from 29 September 2026 onwards.

PSLE Marking Exercise from 12 to 14 October 2026

The PSLE Marking Exercise will take place from 12 to 14 October 2026. These 3 days are non-school days for P1 to P6 students. However, we will be having the following programmes. Notifications will be sent out via PG by end September:

- Support lessons for selected P3 and P5 students.
- Matatalab Coding Enrichment for interested P2 students on one of the days during the PSLE Marking Exercise.

Travel Declaration for Long Weekends

If your child/ward is travelling during the National Day long weekend, please make the necessary declaration for her via Parents Gateway (PG) under Services -> Declare Travels. If there is a need to amend the travel plan, you can do so via the same module in PG. If your child/ward is **not** travelling during the holidays or the long weekends, **no action is required**.

Absences from Weighted Assessments

As with any school day, a student should not be in school if she is **unwell**. Please make the necessary arrangements to bring your child/ward to see a doctor and submit the medical certificate to the Form Teacher upon her return to school. This applies on days when Weighted Assessments take place too.

The purpose of assessment including Weighted Assessments is to check for students' understanding and to provide timely feedback to improve learning. As such, while make-up sessions will not be scheduled for students who are absent from any component(s)/paper(s), **students who miss their written assessment will be given a set of the affected assessment papers as an optional assignment**. They are encouraged to complete the paper at home independently and at one sitting. The subject teacher will mark the assignment and provide feedback on the student's progress. The marks will not be included in the computation of the Overall Performance for the year.

We seek your cooperation to inculcate in our students the need to be responsible and take ownership of their learning in school.
