Note: Parents are invited to join their P1 children to school on 2 January and observe them during recess. Only two adults are permitted to accompany the child into the school on 2 January.






On the First Day of School!

- Your child is to put on her school uniform (pinafore and school blouse) with her nametag.
- Entry point from Side Gates 1 & 2 (gates will be opened at 7.15am)
- Registration & attendance to be at the Indoor Sports Hall (Lower Ponggol). Signage will be put up to direct parents.
- Parent and child to proceed to the school hall; after which teachers will lead students to the classrooms.
- Parents are to stay in the hall for the P1 Parent Engagement session.

Snack Time in Class

- 10-minute snack break in class between 8.30 am and 9.00am
- Students are not to share snacks with their friends for reasons of personal hygiene and food allergies.
- Students will not be allowed to buy snacks from the canteen during lessons.







Snack Time in Class


- What to pack:
 - Nutritious dried food items e.g. cereal, bread, biscuits, buns, muesli bars, fruits, dried fruits, nuts and raisins.
 - No cooked food and/or food items that need to be chilled (e.g. sushi).
 - · No unhealthy snacks e.g. chips and sweetened drinks.
 - Look for the Healthier Choice Symbol (HCS) to guide purchases



School Rules: Attire

- Wear the prescribed school uniform.
 Modification to the uniform is not allowed.
- Wear only white school socks and shoes.
- Must have name tags ironed onto pinafore and school PE T-shirt
- Be neat and properly attired in school uniform at all times, inside and outside school.
- Students to wear the school PE T-shirt on days when they have PE or PAL lessons.
- Pls note that girls are to wear the pinafore on all days to school.





School Rules: Appearance & Accessories

- Hair touches the collar must be tied up.
- Only plain black hair accessories are allowed
- Only small and simple ear studs are allowed (no hoops earrings)
- No smart watches, jewellery or accessories.
- No display of religious accessories.
- Students are not allowed to colour their hair.

School Rules: Attendance

- Attendance is compulsory for all school days, events and activities.
- Parents <u>must inform</u> the school (via Form teacher) if their daughter is absent. Please ensure that a medical certificate or letter of excuse is presented.
- The school will accept a maximum of 3 letters each term for child's absence. A medical certificate should be given otherwise.





School Rules: Punctuality



- Be punctual. Students must be seated in the school hall/classroom by 7.30 a.m. (Monday Friday).
- Parents/Guardians must sign the "Permission to Leave School" form in the General Office to take their child/ward home before the official dismissal time.





School Rules- Late Coming

Other Matters: Handphone/ Smart watch Policy

- Mobile phones and <u>smart watches</u> are not allowed to be used during school hours.
- For handphones, parents must complete the "Request to Bring Mobile Phones" form (sent via PG) if their child needs to bring a phone to school.
- All devices must be switched off during school hours and kept in the student's bag.
- The school is not responsible for any loss or damage to these devices. Failure to follow the rules may result in permission to bring phones or smart watches being revoked More information can be found in the school organiser.



Other Matters: Name Tags

- Students need to have their name tags ironed on their pinafore and on their PE T-shirt.
 - Pinafore: name tags ironed on above the school crest
 - PE T-shirt: on the right side of the T-shirt, aligned to the second button
- Pls refer to the school website (School Information —> School Rules) for the correct positioning of the name tags.
- Purchase of iron-on name tags is compulsory and included in the booklist

- The name tags will be issued to your child by her Form Teachers when they are ready.

Pocket Money

Pocket money should be kept to a minimum, e.g. \$3 to \$4 per day. Students are encouraged to drink plain water from their water bottles or the water coolers.
