Updating of Pupil Particulars Form

With the start of the new school year, we will need to update your contact details and other information. You will receive the Pupil Particulars cum Medical Record Form through your child. Please complete and submit it to your child's Form Teacher by **Friday**, **7 January 2022**.

Temperature-Taking Exercise

As part of our measures to ensure your child's safety, we will be continuing with the daily temperature-taking exercise. Please ensure that your child brings her personal oral digital thermometer (ODT) every day.

All P1 students will be given an (ODT) issued by MOE and this will be kept by the Form Teachers to facilitate the temperature-taking exercises.

School Smart Card (SSC) for P1 and P6 students

There will be a photo-taking session for P1 and P6 students during school hours on the following days:

P1: Friday, 14 January 2022 P6: Monday, 17 January 2022

Your child will need to be in her school uniform (i.e. school blouse and pinafore) for the photo-taking session. If she has a PE lesson that day, please ensure that she has her school blouse packed in her school bag.

P1 students should be able to get their SSC by April 2022. For P6 students, the photo taken that day will be used for the SSC which will be issued in 2023 when she goes to Secondary 1.

For P3 only - Gifted Education Programme (GEP)

- GEP Selection Exercise 18 and 19 October 2022 (Tuesday and Wednesday)

Chinese New Year Celebration on Monday, 31 January 2022

Chinese New Year celebration will be held on Monday, 31 January 2022. This is an opportunity for students and staff of different races to come together and celebrate the Chinese tradition and culture.

Like 2021, in adherence to the safe management measures (SMMs), the blessing of mandarin oranges will be done in the classrooms. Your child can bring along 2 mandarin oranges to school on Monday, 31 January 2022 if she wants to participate in the blessing of oranges.

Your child is to come in her school uniform with school shoes. There will be an online celebration followed by classroom activities.

Please make the necessary transport arrangements for your child to return home if she is not taking the school bus. The school will also operate till 1.00pm on the eve of Chinese New Year.

As the canteen will be closed, we will implement snack time for all levels instead. Please remind your child to bring along healthy dry snacks. There will be no afternoon activities (i.e. CCA, support lessons and enrichment programmes) that day. The bookshop will also be closed that day.

There will be no classes for all students on Tuesday, 1 February 2022 and Wednesday, 2 February 2022. Classes will resume on Thursday, 3 February 2022.
