General Information

Science Textbooks / Workbooks for 2023 P4 and P6

P3 and P5 students should keep their 2022 Science Textbooks and Workbooks for use in 2023 i.e. in P4 and P6. Science textbooks and workbooks are meant to be used over 2 years.

We wish to alert P3 and P5 students who are currently on the Financial Assistance Scheme that there will not be any replacement Science Textbooks and Workbooks in the new academic year, should the books be misplaced or thrown away.

Ordering of Name Tags 2023 for 2022 P1 to P5 students

Your child can submit her orders for names tags to the school bookshop during recess. This will ensure that she has name tags for the year 2023. All students must have the name tag attached to their pinafore / PE t-shirt.

To place the order, your child can collect a Name Tag order form from the General Office. Once completed by you, she can then submit the order form and money to the bookshop. Please note that the colour of the name-tag remains the same for all 6 years.

Parents who intend to sign up either for MOE FAS 2023 or the School-based FAS 2023 should not purchase name tags at this moment.



Absences from Assessments and Examinations

Other than for the Oral Examinations, make-up tests will not be scheduled for students who are absent from any component(s)/ paper(s) from any examination / weighted assessment. Please note that any absence must be supported with a Medical Certificate from a doctor; medical certificates from Traditional Chinese Medicine practitioners will not be recognised. Letters from parents will also not be accepted unless there is a valid reason and this is subject to the Principal's approval.

For our students' well-being, they will not be allowed to take any component(s)/ paper(s) if they are unwell on the day of assessment. Please make the necessary arrangements to bring your child/ward to see a doctor and submit the medical certificate to the Form Teacher upon her return to school.

Students who missed their weighted assessment / year-end assessment papers will be given a set of the affected assessment papers as an optional assignment. They are to complete the paper at home and are encouraged to do so under exam conditions. The subject teacher will mark the assignment and provide feedback on the student's progress. The marks will not be included in the computation of the Overall Performance for the year.
