SCHOOL PROGRAMMES 2018: PRIMARY ONE

- 1. In line with our objective to provide a holistic education for every pupil, the school has planned a range of programmes to give your child opportunities to discover and develop her talents.
- Like in previous years, the school will be subsidizing fully some of these programmes e.g. FIT Party
 while others will be paid for on a co-payment basis. The co-payment amounts will be reflected in the
 School Bill and can be paid for through Edusave withdrawals and/or cash/cheque payments.
- 3. Please note that unlike previous years, you will be receiving a School Bill in February 2018. The School Bill (an initiative of the Ministry of Education) is a statement informing you of your child's enrichment programmes and school charges for each item (e.g. magazine subscription). This is separate from your payment of school fees to MOE (MOE Bill). Please refer to the sample copy of the School Bill and FAQs for more information on School Bill.

4. Please refer to the table below for the amount payable for the programmes.

Programme	Details	Amount to Be Paid by Parent (after school subsidy)
'Read Well' Speech & Drama programme	"Read Well" is a 12-week programme that will take place weekly for an hour each time, <u>during curriculum time</u> . It enhances the girls' phonemic awareness and reading skills, and encourages curiosity and a love for reading through the use of different genres of literature. It also promotes co-operation and enhances confidence through group and class presentations. There will be no refund for withdrawals if your child/ward has already attended at least 50% of the sessions in the programme.	\$40.00
International Friendship Day Field-Based Learning	To commemorate International Friendship Day, the school will be organising a school-wide field-based learning journey (LJ) on Friday, 9 March 2018 during curriculum time. All P1 pupils will be going to the Singapore Zoological Garden that day during curriculum time. There will be co-payment for the entrance fee. We will share more details on the visit with parents nearer the date of the programme.	\$10.00
