SCHOOL PROGRAMMES 2019: PRIMARY FOUR

1. In line with our objective to provide a holistic education for every pupil, the school has planned a range of programmes to give your child/ward opportunities to discover and develop her talents.
2. Like in previous years, the school will be subsidizing fully some of these programmes e.g. Road Safety Games, What's Up Newspaper Subscription while others will be paid for on a co-payment basis. The co-payment amounts will be reflected in the School Bill and can be paid for through Edusave withdrawals and/or cash/cheque payments.
3. You will be receiving a School Bill in February 2019. The School Bill (an initiative of the Ministry of Education) is a statement informing you of your child's /ward's enrichment programmes and school charges for each item (e.g. magazine subscription). This is separate from your payment of school fees to MOE (MOE Bill).
4. Please refer to the table below for the amount payable for the programmes.

School Wide Learning Journey (1)	To commemorate International Friendship Day, the school will be organising a school-wide field-based learning journey (LJ) on Friday, 15 March 2019 during curriculum time . All P4 pupils will be going to Kampong Glam that day during curriculum time. There will be co-payment for the LJ fee. We will share more details with parents nearer the date of the programme.	\$10.00
Physical Science Programme	The workshop will introduce the concepts of Light and Heat to our Primary 4 pupils. The 6-hour workshop will be conducted on either 9 or 10 September 2019 during the September holidays. We will share more details with parents nearer the date of the programme.	\$30.00
G.R.A.C.I.A Explorer Camp	As part of the school's Learning for Life Programme (LLP) to develop resilient and active pupils, our P4 girls will be attending the GRACIA Explorer Camp, their first overnight camp on 7 to 8 November 2019. This camp builds on the values taught over these four years, and will further inspire our girls to live according to the IJ Mission.
