There will be a photo-taking session for P1 and P6 pupils during school hours on Monday, 15 January 2018 for the issue of the School Smart Card (SSC).

Your child will need to be in her school uniform (i.e. school blouse and pinafore) and put on her name tag for the photo-taking session. If she is having a PE lesson on that day, please help to ensure that she:

- wears her PE T-shirt and pinafore to school.
- has her school blouse packed into her school bag.

P1 pupils should be able to get their SSC by April 2018. For P6 pupils, the photo taken that day will be used for the SSC to be issued in 2019 when your child goes to Secondary 1.



Learning Management System (MCOOnline)

The school has a Learning Management System (LMS) for all pupils and this is provided by MCOOnline. The LMS is an online learning portal and is accessible from home. The annual subscription fee per pupil will be borne by the school. Teachers will be issuing the Login ID and password.

Pupils will be prompted to change the password upon the first log-in and are required to change the password every 90 days. Please remind your child to take note of her password and not to share her password with her friends.

Parents are advised to carry out a 'Systems Check' to ensure that the systems in the portal are compatible with your home computer. The guide for the Systems Check is uploaded on the portal. For any technical query, parents may click the "Help" link in the MCOOnline website or call their helpdesk at 6777-5198.

Project *Dream* - School Building Upgrading Updates - Phase 2 (Sept 2017 to Sept 2018)

The school is still in Phase 2 of Project *Dream* where a new classroom block is being constructed in front of the General Office. Parents will only be allowed to drive into the school from 7.20am to 7.40am and drop-off their child at the temporary shelter outside the canteen. For safety purposes, all visitors will access the school from Side Gate 2 instead of the main gate. Please note that all visitors will be required to provide their identification details to the security guards.

If you are driving and need to pick your child up after dismissal / CCA / support lessons, please pick her up from the carpark adjoining Side Gate 2 / Block 465A. There will be no access via the main gate. Please refrain from leaving your car engines on while waiting; the fumes emitted may in turn affect the health of other parents/guardians and pupils who are near the area.
