Children's Day Values in Action (VIA) project

P6 Project Care Food Drive

To provide our P6 pupils with a platform to serve the community and make a difference in the lives of others, our P6 pupils will be organising a food drive project as a post-PSLE activity. This activity requires them to collect non-perishable food items for donation to selected charitable homes.

Do support our P6 pupils by contributing food items to the project. Examples of such food items include rice, uncooked pasta, bottled pasta sauce, biscuits, canned food, powdered beverages like Milo and coffee and sugar etc. We seek your cooperation to ensure that the donated items are halal-certified. CCA Fiesta!

The CCA Fiesta! will be held on Wednesday, 7 November 2018 from 8.00am to 1.30pm. During the CCA Fiesta!, P2 pupils can find out more about the different Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) at the booths manned by the various CCA Leaders. Parents of P2 pupils will receive a CCA Recruitment letter before the Fiesta to help your child decide on the CCA they would like to join in 2019. More details will be provided in the letter.

Current P3 to P5 pupils without a CCA are also welcomed to visit the booths during their recess. They are to approach the respective CCA teacher-in-charge directly to sign up for the CCA.



Financial Assistance Schemes (FAS) 2019

Applications for the MOE FAS 2019 and the School-based FAS 2019 are open.

Singaporean students from households with a gross monthly income of \$2,750 and below (or with a per capita income of \$690 and below) are eligible for MOE FAS. Eligible applicants under the MOE FAS will be eligible for free textbooks, attire, meals and subsidised transport.

Singaporean students from households with a per capita income of \$820 or less can also apply for the School-based FAS 2019. Eligible applicants under the School-based FAS will be eligible for free textbooks and attire.

Do note that 'per capita' refers to the monthly gross monthly income divided by the number of members in the household.

If your child is eligible and you wish to apply for the FAS 2019, please obtain the application form from the General Office. Please submit the completed form and supporting documents to the General Office by Friday, 12 October 2018.

Absences from Examinations and tests

Other than for the Oral Exams, make-up tests will not be scheduled for pupils who are absent from any examination component(s)/ paper(s). Please note that all absences must be supported by a Medical Certificate from a doctor; medical certificates from Traditional Chinese Medicine practitioners will not be accepted. Letters from parents will also not be accepted, unless there is a valid reason and this is subject to the Principal's approval.

For our pupils' well-being, they will not be allowed to take any examination component(s)/ paper(s) if they are unwell on the day of assessment. Please make the necessary arrangements to bring your child/ward to see a doctor and submit the medical certificate to the Form Teacher upon her return to school.

Students who have missed their CA/SA papers will be given a set of the affected assessment papers as an optional assignment. They are to complete the paper at home and are encouraged to do so under exam conditions. The subject teacher will mark the assignment and provide feedback on the student's progress. The marks will not be included in the computation of the Overall Performance for the year.
