The construction works that will be undertaken and their impact on traffic flow for Phase 3 (from 8 Oct 2018 to 30 Sep 2019) is as follows:

Travel Declaration (Online via Learning Management System)

As communicated via Tok-Tok, if your child is travelling overseas during the September holidays, you will need to provide us with her travel details via your child's Learning Management System (LMS) account. Please do so by Friday, 31 August 2018 if you have not already done so. More details can be found on the 'Announcements' page once you have logged onto your child's account at www.mconline.sg.

A "nil" reply is necessary for P1 pupils. For P2 to P6 pupils, there is no need to submit a "nil" reply. For those who do not have computers or internet access at home, please approach the General Office who will then give you a hard copy of the form. 14 Sep (Fri)	PSLE Listening Comprehension (LC) Examinations	Non-school day for P1 to P5 pupils. P6 pupils are to report to the school by 7.40am for Mother Tongue Language (MTL) LC. Those not taking MTL LC will have to report by 10.00am for English Language (EL) LC. They will be dismissed immediately after the LC and not at the usual school dismissal time. All pupils are to report to school on Monday, 17 September 2018.
27 Sep - 3 Oct (Thu - Wed)	PSLE Written Examinations	School will function as per normal for P1 - P5 pupils. P6 pupils will be dismissed at the end of the examination and not at the usual school dismissal time. Lessons will resume for P6s from Thursday, 4 October 2018 onwards.

PSLE candidates who travel to school by train (MRT) should plan their journey so that they would reach the school at least half an hour before the start of the examination. In the event of a train disruption, affected candidates should inform their parents or the school as quickly as possible and continue to make their way to the school to sit for the paper. Those who are late due to a major train service disruption will be given the full duration to sit for the examination, if they arrive before the end of the paper.
